Being boldly interdisciplinary is one aspect of the book's originality, the other being its openess to texts that transgress the strictly academic idiom. The merit of this volume lies in allowing the voices of theatre, film, opera and ballet practicioners, theatre educators and popularizers to be heard very clearly.
